The hotel restaurant is currently not open, but breakfast food is available in the lobby. Amenities include free parking, high-speed internet, a coffee maker in the room, and more.

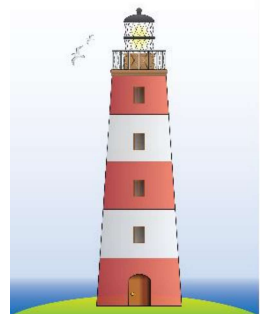

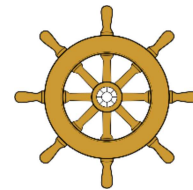
