GFWC Legislation and Public Policy:

Legislative Wrap-Up message from GFWC: As the final session of the 117th Congress comes to a close, GFWC would like to thank their members for their advocacy and action over the past two years. GFWC has been closely monitoring and supporting the 3D Printed Gun Safety Act and Miranda's Law, the two pieces of legislation chosen by GFWC members at the eight Region Conferences in 2018. While these pieces of legislation did not move forward during this Congress, our collective voice surely did not go unheard. In total, 2,641 GFWC members wrote 8,005 letters and made 467 calls in support of these bills. Thank you for the work that each of you has done to move these important bills forward.
