Things to do:

The 103rd Annual Durham Fair is voted the best Connecticut Fair 2023 in the State of Connecticut and is just south of the Hotel in the Town of Durham. Open Thursday to Sunday - Thursday from 4:00 PM to Sunday at 6:00 PM.

Dinosaur State Park is a half mile from the hotel.

In close by Hartford is the Mark Twain House, the Wadsworth Atheneum and Elizabeth Park.

The oldest running Ferry in CT is located in Rocky Hill Ferry Park and takes you across the CT River for \$5 to Glastonbury. Only 3 cars can fit on the Ferry at once.
